The symptoms

 One-third of workers do not feel comfortable taking vacation time. (Deloitte Well-being Survey)

 Knowledge workers spend an average of 104 minutes each month in conference calls. (Wainhouse Research)



The symptoms

 The average hours worked by full-time employees in the U.S. is 47 hours (Gallup)

 60% of work interruptions are caused by social media activities (Hormon.ie)

 Complexity is killing innovation, slowing decisions, and impeding business processes. (SAP)




