Why is certification from ATD CI different?



The ATD Competency Model

- Answers the question: what do people need to know and do for success in various talent development roles?
- Defines the content that is tested on the CPLP certification exams

^{*}ATD CI = The ATD Certification Institute



Earning the CPLP

Eligibility

- Minimum of five years industry-related work experience or the equivalent
 - Four years full-time work experience in the talent development field plus one year of related education or equivalent
- The successful completion of a qualifying ATD Master Series program counts as one year of education

How Achieved

Awarded after passing

- 150-item Knowledge Exam
- 100-item Skills Application Exam in candidate's choice of TD, ID or MLP


Recertification

Continuing professional development is required to maintain the certification; 60 hours every 3 years

CPLP Requirements

CPLP Knowledge Exam


- Measures knowledge
- 150 multiple-choice items
- 10 areas of expertise
- 1 foundational competency, global mindset
- 3 hours at a testing center



CPLP Requirements

CPLP Skills Application Exam


- Measures application
- 100 items
 - 4 case studies; 25 items per case; 5-10 pages of supporting materials with each
 - Mostly multiple-choice items
- Pick one exam area
 - Instructional Design
 - Training Delivery
 - Managing Learning Programs
- 3 hours at a testing center

Knowledge Exam

- ATD National
 - pCPLP Practice Exam
 - Online Learning System
 - Add-on: a synchronous or an on-demand course
- ATD Local Chapters
 - Join study groups locally or online



CPLP Pricing

- CPLP Test Fees:
 - ATD Member: \$900 USD
 - ATD Non Member: \$1250 USD
- Retesting & Transfer Fees: \$300 USD
- Prep Programs: \$300 USD and up
- Recertification Fees: \$200 USD



CPLP Return on Investment

Findings show that the CPLP is valuable to both individuals and organizations:

- Contributes to an 11% improvement in the proficiency of the talent development function
- CPLPs report gains in job confidence, work quality, and program effectiveness.
- For every \$1 dollar invested, there is a \$1.62 return. Comparable programs have a 25-50% rate of return.

CPLP: Putting It All Together

- CPLP -- Certified Professional in Learning and Performance
- Established in 2006 and over 2,000 individuals certified to date
- Geared to advanced talent development professionals
- Our highest certification granted for successful completion of 2 exams:
 - Knowledge Exam validates broad mastery inm10 AOEs.
 Requires 80+ hours of study.
 - Skills Application Exam validates deep mastery of one AOE.
 Requires 40+ hours of study.
- To enter: 5+ years of full-time related work experience or equivalent
- To maintain: 60 professional development credits every 3 years



- Be clear about why you are earning the CPLP.
- Use practice tests to identify knowledge gaps.
- Focus your learning on gaps with a detailed plan.
- Prepare at your own pace.
- Study with people who are and are not earning the CPLP.
- The Learning System is everything.
