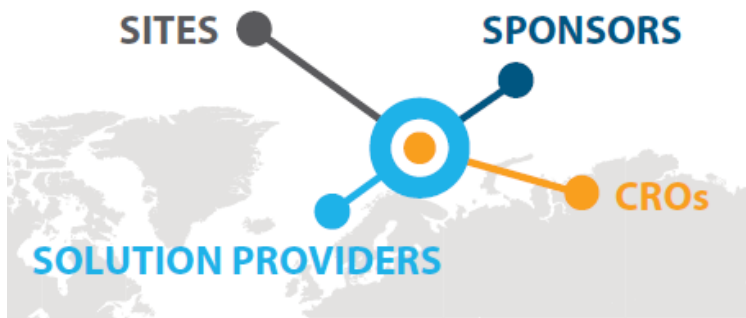


SITE ADVOCACY GROUPS™

The Site Advocacy Group (SAG) is a landmark industry initiative that facilitates meaningful dialogue between site professionals and industry leaders on a variety of topics.

SAGs are convened at the request of a host organization; sponsor, CRO or professional service provider.

The work of the SAG enhances clinical research effectiveness and more closely aligns the work of the sites and industry on current or future projects the host is engaged.





SITE ADVOCACY GROUPS™



Discovery

- Initial discussions to set up scope of project, establish topic(s), review goals and execute contract



SAG Design

- Define qualification criteria for 10 to 12 SAG members
- SAG member search and outreach including CV request and review
- Host and SCRS review CVs and finalize roster
- Determine logistics including SAG member payment reimbursement/honorarium and travel policy



Virtual Orientation Meeting

- Host first meeting with all SAG members to serve as orientation and preparation for in-person meeting



Face to Face Meeting

- Meet for the in-person meeting to discuss preestablished agenda with SAG Members
- Meeting is facilitated and attended by SCRS Senior Project Manager /SAG Coordinator
- SCRS provides notes and meeting minutes for SAG host to help guide strategy for remaining virtual meetings



Subsequent Virtual Meetings (up to 3)

- Schedule virtual meeting(s) with Host and SAG Members
- SCRS will help facilitate and organize all virtual meetings, arrange honoraria payments and provide notes and minutes from each meeting



SAG Completion

- Send final communication/project follow up with SAG members and conduct closing audit with Host to make sure all elements have been met and members paid
- SCRS will provide an executive summary of the SAG to Host that outlines objectives, members, attendance and all meeting minutes

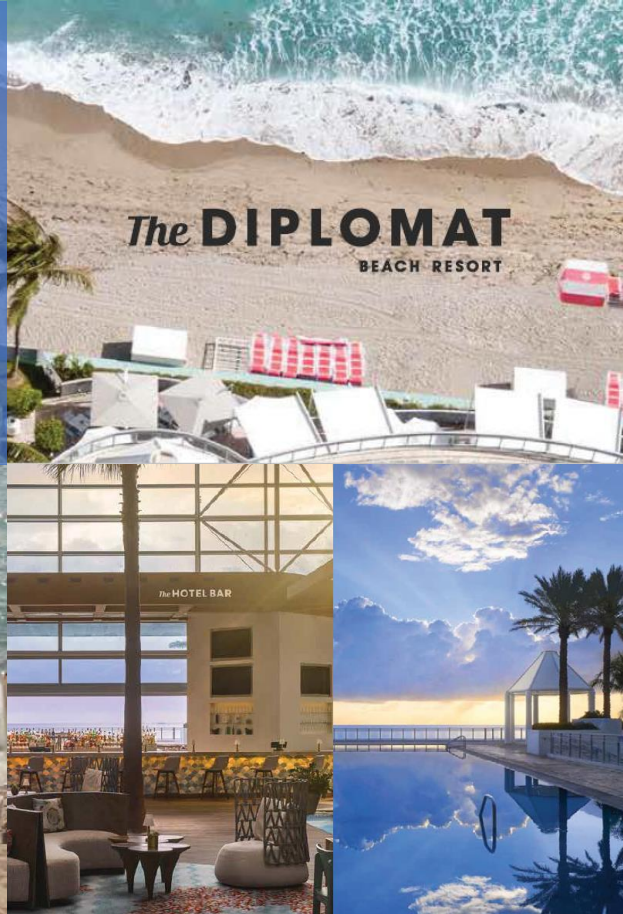
