



- Professional distinction
- Based on industry standards
- Indicates commitment to lifelong learning

It is not a course- you come into the process already having done **professional development** and with a certain amount of **work experience**.







CERTIFICATION INSTITUTE

ATD & CI

ATD is a professional organization for talent development professionals.

ATD CI was formed in 2005 under ATD as a separate entity measuring and evaluating professional standards.

ATD CI Certifications are based on the ATD Talent Development

Released in 2019


 Subject Matter Experts decided the content of the exams based on the years of experience.

Professional Certifications rest on the three legs of:

Eligibility Requirements (to earn)
Examination (to earn)
Recertification (to maintain)

Top 5 Reasons for Earning an ATD CI Certification

Indicates professional growth

APTD Eligibility Requirements



3 Years of Work Experience

Working with adults, performing talent development activities as described in the Developing Professional Capability and/or Impacting Organizational Capability domains of the Talent Development Capability Model

28 Hours of Professional Development

Learning by taking courses, attending conferences, or watching webcasts that cover topics in the Developing Professional Capability and/or Impacting Organizational Capability domains of the Talent Development Capability Model



A closer look at the Professional and Organizational Capabilities

APTD Facts and Figures

Established in 2017

Created for early-career professionals and those with a narrower job focus

2-hour exam with 115 multiple choice questions

Must score a 500 on a scale of 200-800

Currently has a 68.3% overall pass rate

Over 1000 APTD certifications have been earned.

Largest APTD population outside the US is in Saudi Arabia and China.

Certificants report that it takes between 3-6 months to prepare to test once they decide they want to pursue certification.

To recertify, you must have 45 hours of professional development every 3 years.

A closer look at the Professional and Organizational Capabilities

CPTD Facts and Figures

Established in 2006

Created for TD professionals who want to lead people or distinguish themselves from others

3-hour exam with 90 multiple choice questions and 10 case management questions

Must score a 500 on a scale of 200-800

Currently has a 73.7% overall pass rate

Over 3000 APTD certifications have been earned.

CPTDs can be found on every continent except Antarctica.

Certificants report that it takes between 6-9 months to prepare to test once they decide they want to pursue certification.

To recertify, you must have 60 hours of professional development every 3 years.

APTD vs. CPTD

Comparing the two certifications must be done on several levels.

Otherwise, it's going to be like comparing oranges and apples.

4. Additional considerations

 Look at sample questions and gap assessments in handbooks

Read some blogs or watch prior webcasts featuring certificants

• Finally, how do you wash an elephant?

Prepare to prepare

Understand everyone's journey will be different (there is no silver bullet)

Identify your particular gaps (focus on your weaker areas)

Create a personal plan that includes a target testing window, support and accountability partners (the hardest part is sticking to a plan)

Understand that the exam is *practice based* and will require you to *apply* what you know - not just recall memorized terms

Successful certificants report that studying with a buddy or in a group were invaluable to their process





Starting Feels Like the Hardest Part

Make a "To Do" list

Talk to a trusted colleague or mentor about your thoughts on earning a certification

Make it a 2023 goal to earn Write it down!

Talk to an APTD or CPTD about their experiences or consider talking to an ATD CI Staff Member ATD CI Office Hours are every 1st Friday!

If you decide you want to do it, it's just like training for a race or practicing for a recital.

It takes work and a desire to earn it.
