Stage Gate PROCESS



CHECKPOINTS

There are a few checkpoints to include in your project:



Stage gates are set to ensure certain elements are finalized before project costs (such as narration and purchasing of stock photos/videos) are expended.



There are still stakeholder reviews to consider. Determining the proper stage gate will ensure the product is in a "steady state" for that level of reviewer.




Projects still have deadlines and go-live dates. Checkpoints ensure projects do not enter a do-loop of edits without ever progressing to completion.






